



On 08/09/2017, From our college 50 students and 5 faculties have participated in the Literacy Day Program held in our campus and are aware of literacy rate and importance of literacy.





According to the etu.org.za website, in 1990 the life expectancy of people living with HIV/AIDS was 60 years. This has decreased tremendously over the past few years, and


